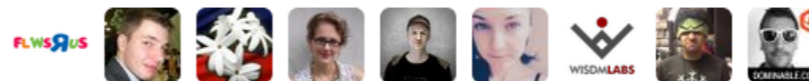

So you want to be a theme reviewer? That's great. The team is open to anyone and you can easily get started following these steps.

1. Get access to Trac. All the themes live at [themes.trac.wordpress.org](https://themes.trac.wordpress.org). You will need access to this with a WordPress.org user account.
2. Join Slack. Visit [chat.wordpress.org](https://chat.wordpress.org) and sign up using your WordPress.org user account. You can then join the theme review team in #themereview. All our meetings are done in Slack, we advise all reviewers to at least try and attend the weekly one on Tuesday's at 18:00 UTC.
3. Subscribe to the blog on [make.wordpress.org/themes](https://make.wordpress.org/themes). Being subscribed to this blog lets you keep in touch with the team and updates.
4. Set up your testing environment.
  - First up, you will need a testing installation. We advise at the start you following this guide on [setting up Vagrant](#).
  - Import the [theme unit test data](#) into your installation. This gives you all the content you will need to run tests.
  - Set `WP_DEBUG` to `'true'` in your `wp-config.php` file.
  - Install the following Plugins (**Note: all plugins below can be installed via the Developer plugin**):

Hi! Sorry, I'm late... Here comes the review:

## Theme Check

### REQUIRED

- `<title>` tag should only contain `wp_title()` function. For customization you should use `wp_title` filter.
- `post_class()` is missing in the `<article>` tag on `single.php`

## Licence

### REQUIRED

- Should specify the theme is under the GPL after the theme like: "Constructzine Lite is distributed under the terms of the GNU GPL"
- Which is the bundled images license?

## Theme documentation

### REQUIRED

- The Theme URI should be a page with info about the theme. In this case you used a demo site so the content must be related to the theme itself and not test data.

## Code Quality

### REQUIRED

- You should not hardcode charset on the meta located in header
- As you're prefixing all theme's functions with 'ti\_', i found one function and a class that have different prefix:
  - Function `constructzine_customizer()` located in `includes/customizer.php`
  - Class `Example_Customize_Textarea_Control` located in `includes/customizer.php`

## Stylesheets & Scripts

### REQUIRED

- You don't need to enqueue `jquery` as it enqueues itself when you put it as a dependency from the Carousel.

## Layout

### REQUIRED

- Titles too long page title breaks subnav: <https://cloudup.com/cq1iCruveT1>
